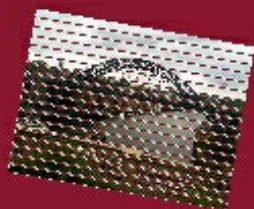



Bus pick-up points

Billingham - outside the station next to the footbridge.

Darlington - at the top of Victoria Road close to the station car park entrance.

Gypsy Lane - on the junction of Gypsy Lane and The Avenue - next to the Brunton Arms pub for Middlesbrough, and the opposite side for Nunthorpe.

Hartlepool - from bus stop 4 in front of the station.

Heworth - at the bus stop on A184 for Newcastle. At the Metro bus replacement stop for Sunderland.

James Cook - at the bus stop on Marton Road outside the main hospital entrance.

Marton - the bus stops on Ladgate Lane - same side of the road as the station for Nunthorpe, and the opposite side for Middlesbrough.

Metrocentre - the bus stop over the bridge, in front of the station.

Middlesbrough - in the layby on Bridge Street at the back of the station.

Newcastle - in front of the station.

Nunthorpe - service bus stops on Guisborough Road, by the entrance to the station car park for Whitby, outside the Nunthorpe Early Years Centre for Middlesbrough.

Seaham - at the station car park.

Seaton Carew - the bus stop on Station Lane, next to the junction with Stanmore Grove.

Stockton - on Bishopron Lane, at the bottom of the station road.

Sunderland - at the bus stops on Fawcett Street, next to the junction with Athenaeum Street.

Thornaby - at the ramp leading to the station platform.

We're sorry but we can't carry dogs or non-folding prams, pushchairs, bikes and wheelchairs on the replacement buses.

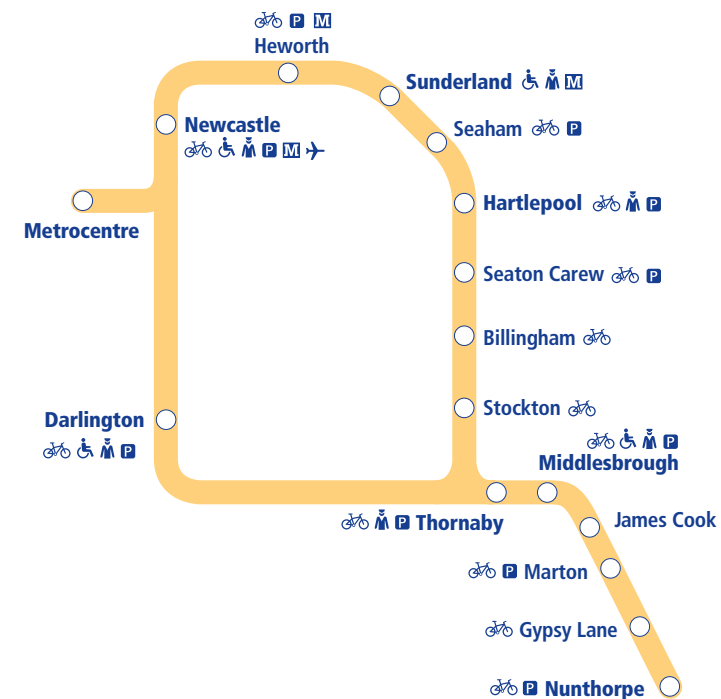

This timetable is a summary of our train services between Nunthorpe, Middlesbrough, Newcastle and Metrocentre. Other trains run between Newcastle and Metrocentre, Newcastle and Darlington, and Metro trains run between Newcastle and Sunderland.

 Services between Newcastle and Sunderland are run for NEXUS.

Through trains and connections

At the side of the station name **a** means arrival time and **d** means departure time. If the train times are in **bold type** you won't have to change trains.

If your arrival time is shown in light type, change at the previous station whose time is printed in bold type unless a footnote gives other instructions.

If your departure time is shown in light type, change at the next station whose time is printed in bold type unless a footnote gives other instructions.



Buying your ticket

It's a legal requirement to have a valid ticket or pass before you start your journey and you risk prosecution if you travel without one.

You must buy your ticket from the ticket office or ticket vending machine **before** getting on the train. If the ticket office is closed or you board at an unstaffed station you can buy your ticket from the conductor on the train. If you avoid using the ticket office or vending machine when they're available, the conductor will charge you the full Anytime Single/Return fare.
